Having examined the project application **R1 Nitra západ – Selenec highway**
which is to be located at **cadaster Lehota, Lužianky, Mlynárce, Kynek, Nitra, Horné
Krškany, Veľké Janíkovce, Chrenová**

we declare that (tick the appropriate box):

**The project is not likely to have significant effects on a site of nature
conservation importance on the following grounds:**

Planned highway connects already functional section of the Tmava – Nitra highway on
crossroad by the Lehota Village, continues along the south periphery of the town of Nitra and
ends on the Selenec crossroad. It goes along vineyards, through Kynecký les and agricultural
land. Over the residential zone, industrial part of the town of Nitra and over the Nitra River
the highway is leaded by flyovers. The aim of building of the highway is the traffic diversion,
improving of the traffic and living conditions of the town of Nitra.

There are not any Natura 2000 sites (sites of Community importance – SCIs, SKUEV and
special protection areas – SPAs, SKCHVU) in instant distance from the planned highway.
The closed are the SKUEV0176 Dvorčiansky les situated in distance about 2.4 km to the
south-east and the SKUEV130 Zoborské vrchy about 2.7 km north from the Selenec
crossroad. Situation is specified on the enclosed map.

All project activities have been approved according to the national legislation (territorial planning
or building permit procedure) and to all of them the official opinion from the involved nature and
landscape protection Authority was needed.

Therefore an appropriate assessment required by Article 6 (3) of Directive
92/43/EEC was not deemed necessary.
