which is to be located at cadaster **Hubová, Ružomberok – Hrboltová, Likavka,  
Martinček, Lisková, Ivachnová**

**Following an appropriate assessment, according to Art. 6(3) of Directive 92/43/EEC, the  
project will not have significant negative effects on a site of nature conservation  
importance:**

The aim of the Project is aimed to continue building the D1 highway in next section. This part is  
linked to the planned Turany – Hubová highway with lining up to the existing I/18 road in the  
Hubová cadaster. It crosses the I/18 road, the River of Váh, and rail, next around the Hrboltová  
village, in to the Čebrať tunnel (2 km long). Next it is led around the Martinček and Likavka  
village community and again crosses the I/18 road, the River of Váh, and rail. Then southly  
around the Lazy village it connects to the existing highway in Ivachnová.

Proposed highway crosses 2 times (bridges) the site of Community importance SKUEV0253  
Rieka Váh. An evaluation form required for the appropriate assessment was developed as a basis  
for the official opinion under §28a of the Act No. 543/2002 on Nature and Landscape Protection  
Coll. as amended. The official opinion states, that the Project will not have a significant effect  
on the site Natura 2000. There are also 2 NATURA 2000 sites located near proposed section is  
SKUEV0305 Choč (app. 0.8 km to the north) and the special protected area SKCHVU033 Veľká  
Fatra (app. 2.5 km to the southwest). Detailed situation is specified in the enclosed map.

All project activities have been approved according to the national legislation (territorial planning or  
building permit procedure) and to all of them the official opinion from the involved nature and  
landscape protection Authority was needed.

A map at scale of 1: 50.000 (or the nearest possible scale) is attached indicating the location of  
the Project as well as the site of nature conservation importance concerned if any.
